REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

The Norwegian authorities have requirement towards workers using fallprotection equipment in their work, that they have to undergo training in the use of these equipments ("regulations on the execution of work" No. 1357, § 10-2 requirement for documented safety training through the use of work equipment). The employer is responsible for ensuring that the employee has the necessary training. The course provides a basic theoretical and practical introduction to fall-protection. Certificate of competence is issued to participants to meet legal requirements for documentation.
